

- 1. The Junior Membership at Coombe Wood LTC is divided into 2 categories:
- Cadets up to age 8 (age as at 1st May on any given year).
- Juniors up to age 18 (age as at 1st May on any given year).
- 2. Juniors must follow the Code of Conduct for Juniors which is in our Safeguarding Policy, you will find a copy on the club noticeboard.
- 3. When can Juniors play and which courts can they use?

Courts can only be booked using the on-line booking system which can be accessed via the Club website. Court availability is rarely a problem, but there are times when courts are reserved for specific purposes as shown on the booking system. In accordance with the booking system rules:

Parent members and juniors aged 13 and over can currently book courts as follows:

Weekdays: Morning and afternoon slots

Saturdays: Morning and evening slots

Sundays: Afternoon and evening slots

- Juniors under 13 and cadets cannot book courts themselves they will need a parent/carer to book on their behalf.
- 4. Juniors under 13 years of age must be supervised at all times by their parent or carer whilst at the club outside of any coaching lessons or tennis camps. This is in accordance with LTA guidelines on Safeguarding.
- 5. No play is permitted on Finals Day. See Club website for date.
- 6. Music is not allowed to be played on court, except by the coaches as part of the coaching programme.
- 7. Mobiles and other electronic devices may be used to contact parents but please switch them off during play.
- 8. Recognised tennis wear to be worn on court. Tracksuits or leggings can be worn on cold days but NO JEANS. Tennis shoes/trainers with non-marking soles are essential. No heavy ribbed soles or school shoes permitted on court. Juniors will be sent home if footwear is incorrect.
- 9. Jumping over the nets, leaning against or climbing the netting is not permitted. Players only on the courts please.
- 10. Please leave the changing rooms in the clubhouse clean and tidy.
- 11. No Juniors are allowed behind the bar at any time.
- 12. Juniors are not permitted to play darts.



Information for Juniors

13. Table tennis:

- Juniors can use the table tennis table when it is out.
- If it is folded up, on no account should juniors attempt to unfold it or move it themselves. It is dangerous to do so.
- Bats and balls are available in a basket in the table tennis room and must be returned to the basket after use.
- Do not place any items, especially food or drink, on the table.
- Do not sit or climb on the table.

14. Visitors:

- Juniors can bring their parents/carers or other juniors as visitors to the club. They can not sign in an adult vistor other than their parent/carer.
- All visitors must be registered on the booking system at the time of making the court booking.
- The same visitor, including parent/carer visitors, can only play 6 times in a year.
- The visitor charges are currently £3.00 per junior and £7 per adults. These may change from time to time as detailed on the club website.
